## FINAL DOCUMENT of the 30<sup>th</sup> Session of the Baltic Assembly

The Baltic Assembly,

**having convened** on 24–25 November 2011 in Tallinn, the Republic of Estonia, for its 30<sup>th</sup> Session,

having discussed the latest developments in the cooperation of the Baltic States, sustainable energy market in the region, progress of implementation of joint health-care projects, migration tendencies, joint infrastructure projects as well as human security issues,

**adopted** the following documents:

- **Resolution** of the 30<sup>th</sup> Session of the Baltic Assembly;
- **Statement** on the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Baltic Assembly and the perspectives of cooperation;

adopted amendments to the Baltic Assembly Statutes;

approved the Baltic Assembly Budget Report for 2010;

**adopted** the Baltic Assembly Budget for 2012;

**defined** the following priorities of the Baltic Assembly for 2012:

- 1) enhancing the integration and stability of financial markets of the Baltic and Nordic countries;
- 2) developing innovative and competitive economy of the Baltic States;
- 3) increasing homeland security;
- 4) Baltic-Nordic Idea: cultural integration of the region;

**defined** the following priorities for cooperation between the Baltic Assembly and the Baltic Council of Ministers for 2012:

- 1) joint measures and projects enhancing economic growth and employment;
- 2) creation of single digital market;
- 3) development of the Baltic energy market, and

**decided** that the 31<sup>st</sup> Session of the Baltic Assembly will take place on 8–9 November 2012 in Vilnius, the Republic of Lithuania.
