on Relations and Cooperation with Ukraine

The Baltic Assembly

regarding the independent Republic of Ukraine as a very important stabilising factor in Central and Eastern Europe;

taking into account Ukraine's progress along the road of democratization and integration into the European political, economic and security structures and its active participation in the solution of international problems;

understanding Ukraine's desire to develop its economic, trade and other relations with Central, Western and Northern European countries, including Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania,

urges the parliaments and governments of the three Baltic States to foster their relations with Ukraine and promote political, economic and cultural cooperation, including cooperation in European and other international organizations.
