

FINAL DOCUMENT
of the 44th Session of the Baltic Assembly

The Baltic Assembly,

having convened for its 44th Session on 13-14 November 2025 in Riga, the Republic of Latvia,

having discussed the results of the Latvian presidency of the Baltic Assembly, current affairs, and cooperation of the Baltic States, as well as the transport connectivity in the region,

adopted the Resolution of the 44th Session of the Baltic Assembly;

approved the Report on the Implementation of the Budget of the Baltic Assembly for 2024;

adopted the Budget of the Baltic Assembly for 2026;

approved the Decision on the Leadership of the Presidium and the Committees of the Baltic Assembly in 2026;

defined the following priorities of the Baltic Assembly for 2026:

- 1) secure and resilient region through coordinated strategies,
- 2) strong physical, digital, and energy connectivity,
- 3) innovation-driven regional competitiveness;

defined the following priorities for cooperation between the Baltic Assembly and the Baltic Council of Ministers for 2026:

- 1) regional security, including food security and the resilience of supply chains,
- 2) cross-border connectivity, including *Rail Baltica* and the protection of critical infrastructure,
- 3) comprehensive and continuous support for Ukraine at all levels;

decided that the 45th Session of the Baltic Assembly will take place on 22–23 October 2026 in Tallinn, the Republic of Estonia.
