## FINAL DOCUMENT of the 41st Session of the Baltic Assembly

The Baltic Assembly,

having convened for its 41st Session on 27-28 October 2022 in Riga, the Republic of Latvia,

having discussed current affairs and cooperation of the Baltic states, fostering a strong and united Baltic society prepared to meet the challenges posed by external threats as well as immediate actions and long-term solutions for building resilient, interconnected and closely coordinated energy systems in the Baltic States,

adopted the Resolution of the 41st Session of the Baltic Assembly;

approved the Baltic Assembly Budget Report for 2021;

adopted the Baltic Assembly Budget for 2023;

**approved** the Decision on the Leadership of the Presidium and the Committees of the Baltic Assembly in 2023;

defined the following priorities of the Baltic Assembly for 2023:

- 1) Safe and resilient Baltic States;
- 2) Baltic cooperation through unity, solidarity and support;
- 3) Sustainable development of the Baltic States;

**defined** the following priorities for cooperation between the Baltic Assembly and the Baltic Council of Ministers for 2023:

- 1) Regional security and protection;
- 2) Energy security and security of supply;
- 3) Supporting Ukraine (rebuilding and EU integration etc.);

**decided** that the 42<sup>nd</sup> Session of the Baltic Assembly will take place on 23-24 November 2023 in Tallinn, the Republic of Estonia.
